How powerful is Algeria in emerging markets?

Algeria has a power score of 1.75, which puts it at rank 70 in the Emerging Markets power ranking. In comparison to 2023, Algeria has dropped in the power rankings by 7 places, from rank 63, to rank 70. At 1.75, the power score of Algeria is worse than than the regional average of 1.8 in the Africa region and puts it at rank 24 in the region.
