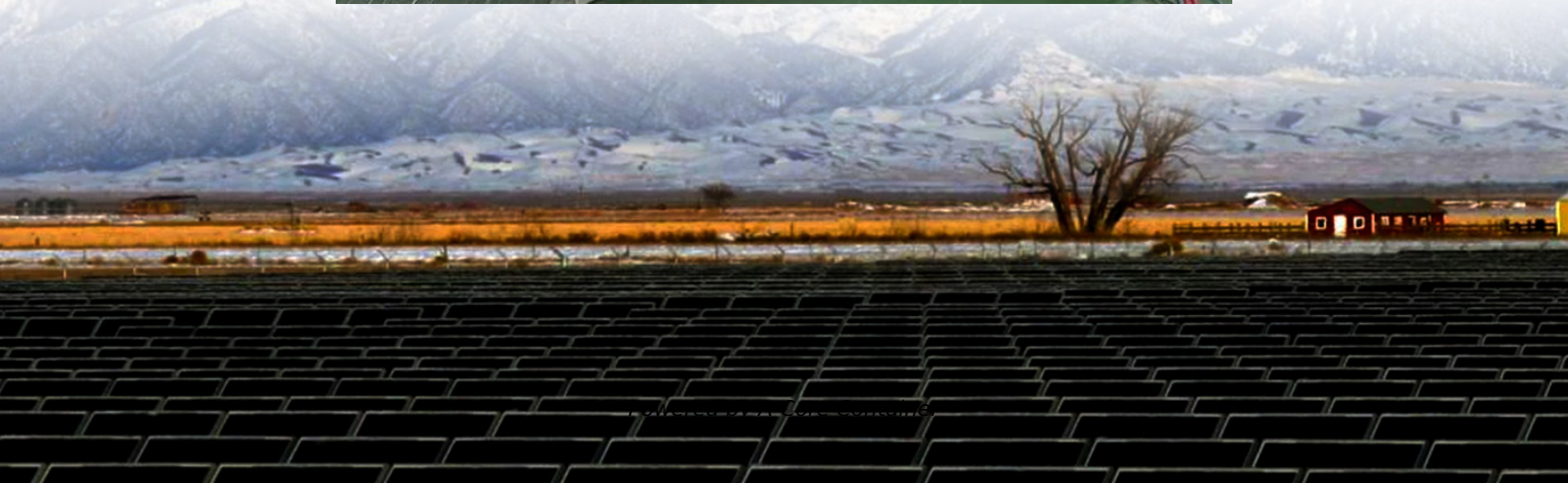

In July 2022, Mercosur approved a 10 percent reduction in the CET for over 80 percent of product lines, lowering the average CET from 8.5 percent to 7.1 percent. Are 'reciprocal tariffs' applied to imports from Uruguay?

"Reciprocal Tariffs": Uruguay was included in the 90-day pause on the higher "reciprocal tariffs" that went into effect on April 9, 2025, for most countries with trade imbalances. Therefore, the higher, specific tariff rates calculated based on the trade deficit are not currently applied to imports from Uruguay.

What percentage of GDP is exported in Uruguay?

Uruguay, Exports of goods and services as percentage of GDP is 30.48 %. Tariffs imposed by Uruguay in 2021 are below. The maximum rate of tariff in percentage on any product is 35. The simple average tariff across all products is 9.88. The trade weighted average tariff is 5.25.

What percentage of Uruguayan exports are made under a trade agreement?

In fact, 32% of Uruguayan exports are made under some trade agreement. When added to products entering through tariff quotas, this percentage rises to 36%. In addition, 58% of the goods exported by Uruguay enter with zero tariffs at destination thanks to the Most Favored Nation (MFN) principle.
