Base station dedicated battery model



Overview

Among various battery technologies, Lithium Iron Phosphate (LiFePO₄) batteries stand out as the ideal choice for telecom base station backup power due to their high safety, long lifespan, and excellent thermal stability. Can a virtual battery model be used for a base station?

Grounded in the spatiotemporal traits of chemical energy storage and thermal energy storage, a virtual battery model for base stations is established and the scheduling potential of battery clusters in multiple scenarios is explored.

Why do communication base stations use battery energy storage?

Meanwhile, communication base stations often configure battery energy storage as a backup power source to maintain the normal operation of communication equipment [3, 4]. Given the rapid proliferation of 5G base stations in recent years, the significance of communication energy storage has grown exponentially [5, 6].

Why do cellular communication base stations need a battery alloc?

Current cellular communication base stations are facing serious problems due to the mismatch between the power outage situations and the backup battery supporting abilities. In this paper, we proposed BatAlloc, a battery allocation framework to address this issue.

How does a battery group work in a base station?

The equipment in base stations is usually supported by the utility grid, where the battery group is installed as the backup power. In case that the utility grid interrupts, the battery discharges to support the communication switching equipment during the period of the power outage.

How many battery groups does a base station have?

The original battery allocation result is largely skewed that over 65 percent base stations are equipped with only one battery group. Our framework

considers both the base station situations and battery features, allocating 2 battery groups to most base stations and 3 or 4 battery groups to those with long-time power outages.

Which battery is best for telecom base station backup power?
