In Bulgaria, the government's elevated fees for photovoltaic (PV) panels and energy storage batteries are hindering the potential for lower electricity prices. The Association for Production, Storage, and Trading of Electricity (APSTE) has raised concerns that these excessive costs not only impact.

The Ministry of Energy announced for public consultation a procedure by which Bulgarian households can benefit from financing for the construction of photovoltaic systems. Eligible applicants are all natural persons, Bulgarian citizens, citizens of another Member State of the European Union or.

Bulgarian houses can request grants for photovoltaic or pv systems and also solar collectors for their own consumption up until November 10.
