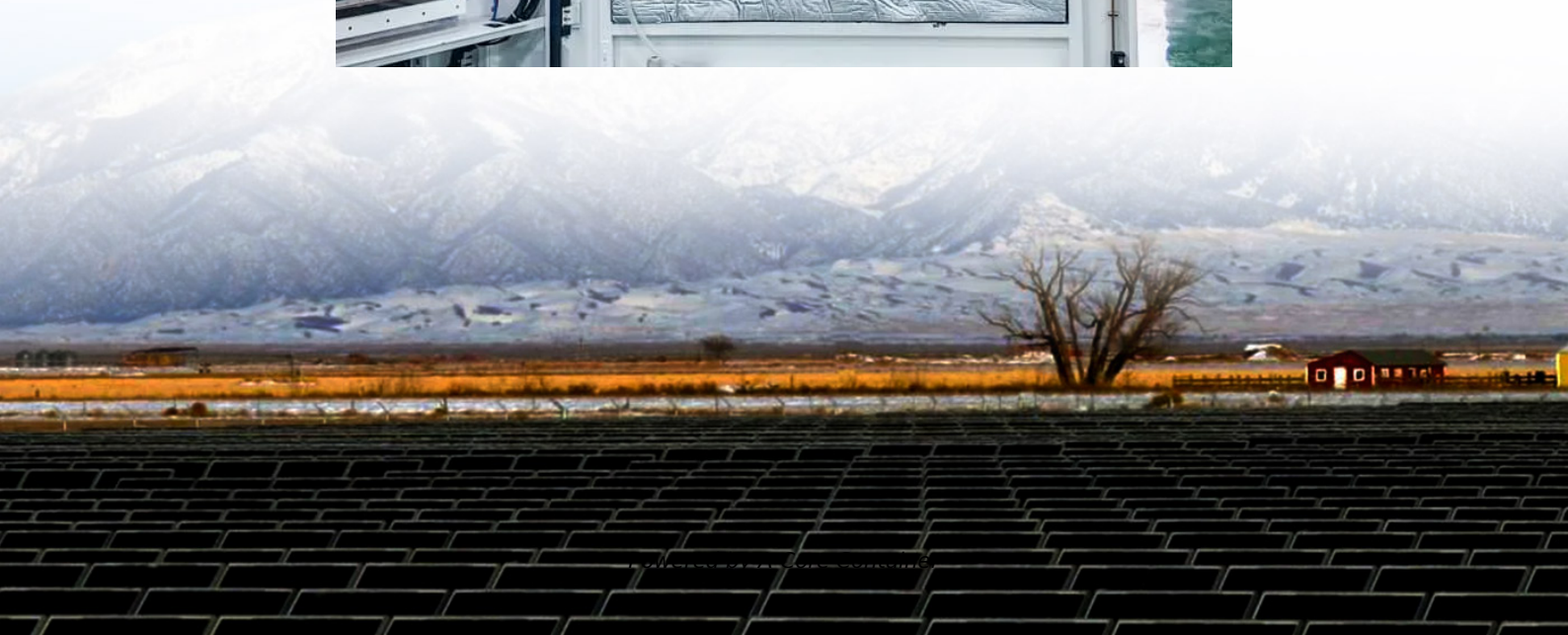

Commonly used solar panel sizes



Overview

The standard solar panel size measures an average of 5.4 by 3.25 feet or 65 by 39 inches. This can cover up to 15 square feet of an area. What are the different sizes of solar panels?

There are 3 standardized sizes of solar panels, namely: 60-cell solar panels size. The dimensions of 60-cell solar panels are as follows: 66 inches long, and 39 inches wide. That's basically a 66×39 solar panel. But what is the wattage?

What are the different types of solar panels?

How big is a 96 cell solar panel?

96-cell solar panel size. The dimensions of 96-cell solar panels are as follows: 41.5 inches long, and 63 inches wide. That's a 63×41.5 solar panel. This form is a bit shorter but wider. This is the typical classification of solar panel sizes (based on the solar cell size). It's a bit theoretical and quite useless for most calculations.
