Do I need to install solar panels on my roof

Should you replace your roof and install solar panels together?

The good news is that you can potentially avoid these costs if you replace your roof and install solar panels close together. Because asphalt shingles and solar panels have similar life expectancies, your solar panels should be due for retirement by the time you're ready to replace your roof again.

When should you install solar panels on a new roof?

Solar panels and roof shingles have similar life spans, so it makes sense to install roof-mounted solar panels soon after you get a new roof. If you put new solar panels on an older roof, you may have to take them down and reinstall them when it's time to replace your roof.

Do you need a roof check before installing solar panels?

A detailed roof check is needed before installing solar panels. Look at the roof's structure, age, and condition. Fix any issues to ensure it can hold the solar system. Discover essential roof requirements for solar panels. Learn about pitch, load capacity, and materials to ensure your home is ready for a solar energy system.

How much does it cost to replace a roof before solar?

If you have an asphalt roof over 5-10 years old, you'll probably want to replace

it before going solar. Replacing your roof and installing solar costs about \$30,000. If you need to replace your roof after you install solar panels, expect solar panel removal and reinstallation to cost anywhere from \$1,500 to \$6,000.

Should you replace your roof if you have a solar system?

Ty Sauer, a development manager with the RES Group, a large independent renewable energy company, explained to us that “for a newer build home of less than five years, there is minimal concern of replacing the roof” during the lifetime of a solar panel system.
