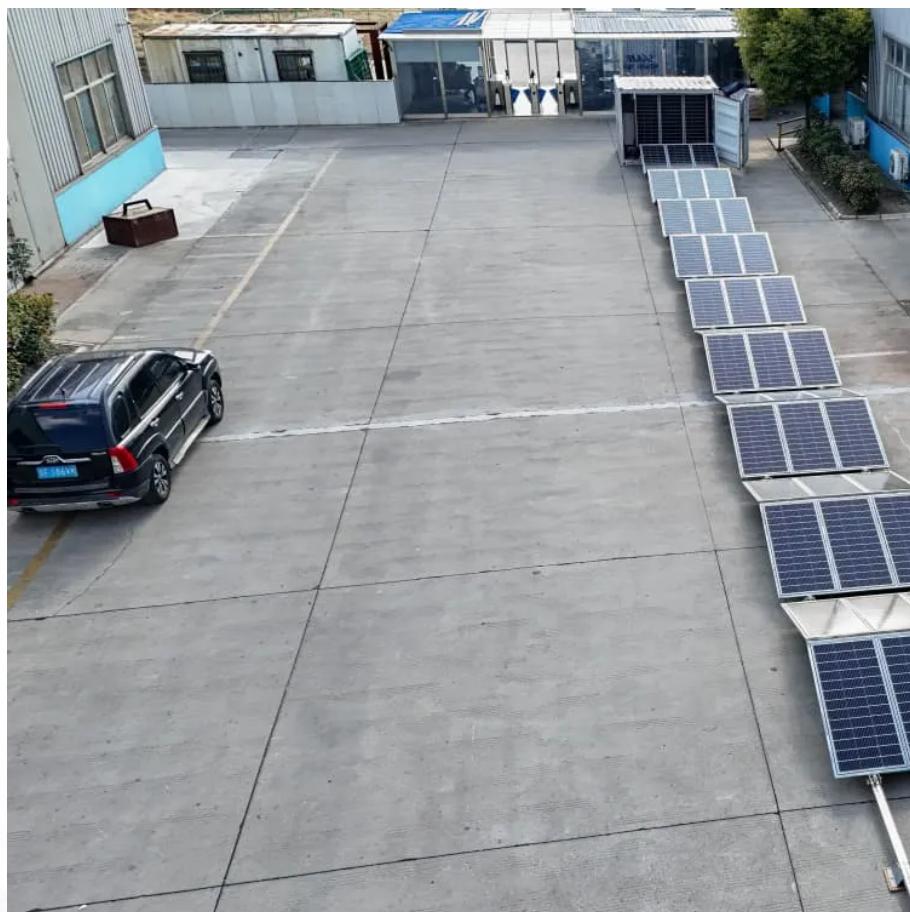

Energy Storage Industrial Park Project Implementation Plan



Overview

What is a bulk energy storage implementation plan?

The Implementation Plan provides an operating framework for the program, with additional details to be provided in Bulk Energy Storage program solicitations.

When will energy storage projects be regulated?

The storage industry anticipates this to be passed into law in 2022, and that it will apply to projects that achieved commercial operation after December 31, 2020, reducing the risks and uncertainty in energy storage project economics.

What is New York state's energy storage plan?

New York State aims to reach 1,500 MW of energy storage by 2025 and 6,000 MW by 2030. Energy storage is essential for creating a cleaner, more efficient, and resilient electric grid. Additionally, these projects will provide meaningful benefits to Disadvantaged Communities and Low-to-Moderate Income New Yorkers.

What is NYSERDA's energy storage plan?

Accordingly, the Order directs NYSERDA “to include in each bulk procurement a target of 20 percent of long-duration, 8-hour energy storage resources, to move New York towards installing the necessary amount of LDES by the mid-2030s.”⁹ NYSERDA therefore proposes to procure, within each solicitation, projects in two separate resource categories.

What is New York's energy storage roadmap?

The Roadmap proposed a comprehensive set of recommendations to expand New York's energy storage programs to cost-effectively unlock the rapid growth of renewable energy across the State and bolster grid reliability and customer resilience.

How will energy storage impact New York?

Storage will increase the resilience and efficiency of New York's grid, which will be 100% carbon-free electricity by 2040. Additionally, energy storage can stabilize supply during peak electric usage and help keep critical systems online during an outage. All of this while creating an industry that could employ at least 30,000 New Yorkers by 2030.
