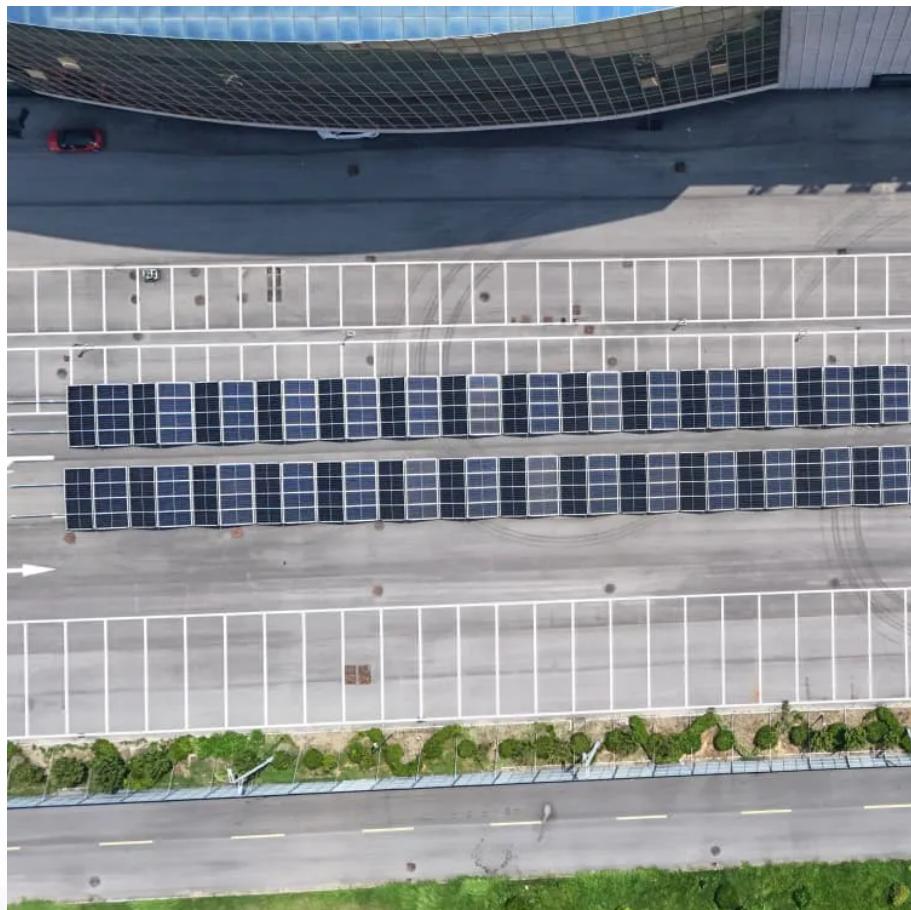

Gambia outdoor power supply parameters



Overview

What type of energy is used in Gambia?

Renewable energy here is the sum of hydropower, wind, solar, geothermal, modern biomass and wave and tidal energy. Traditional biomass – the burning of charcoal, crop waste, and other organic matter – is not included. This can be an important energy source in lower-income settings. Gambia: How much of the country's energy comes from nuclear power?

What voltage does Gambia use?

Gambia operates on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz. Electricity supplies worldwide can vary from anything between 100V and 240V. It can be extremely dangerous to use an electrical appliance that is rated at a voltage different from the supply.

Is biomass a source of electricity in Gambia?

Traditional biomass – the burning of charcoal, crop waste, and other organic matter – is not included. This can be an important source in lower-income settings. Gambia: How much of the country's electricity comes from nuclear power?

Nuclear power – alongside renewables – is a low-carbon source of electricity.

How much electricity will Gambia generate in 2025?

The Gambia's Electricity Sector Roadmap (2019-2025) aims to scale up electricity generation to 200 MW of available capacity at peak in 2025, with 14MW expected from the OMVG project with Guinea and Senegal, and 50MW from the Souapiti project and the remainder through Independent Power Producers (IPP).
