Taipei uses power outlets and plugs of types A & B. Take a look at the pictures below to see what these plugs and power sockets look like: Doesn't look familiar?

Do the outlets look different in your country?

You'll need a power plug adapter. Type A - Mostly used in the US, Canada, Mexico, Central.

In Taipei, they use Type A and B power plugs and outlets. The voltage is 110V, and the frequency is 60Hz. Good news! You won't need a travel adapter in Taipei. Their plugs and outlets are the same as our standard Type A and B back in the States. Need a travel adapter?

No, you don't need a travel.

Which power outlets do they use in Taiwan?

Taiwan uses the same Type A/B outlet as the United States, which are the twin vertical prongs (Type B has an additional grounding pin underneath). Outlets in Taiwan are generally quite safe and well-constructed. The standard voltage used in Taiwan is 110 V.
