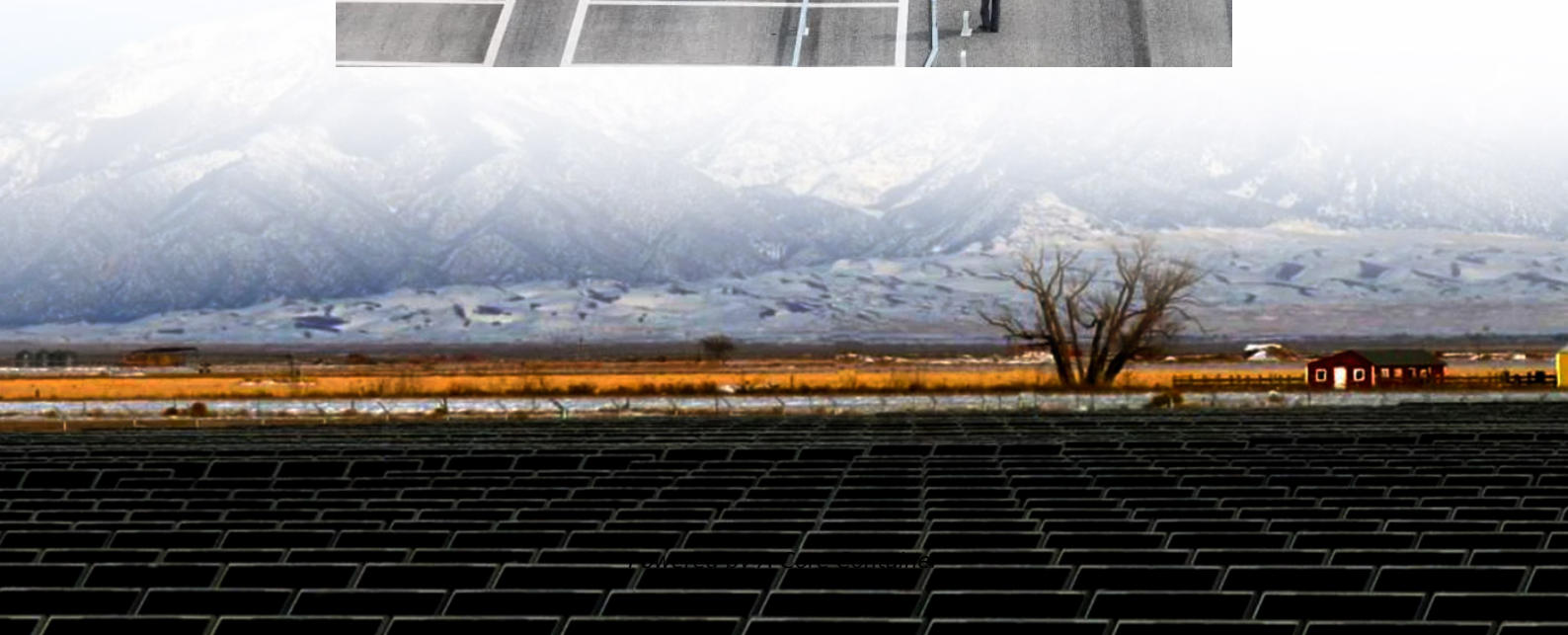
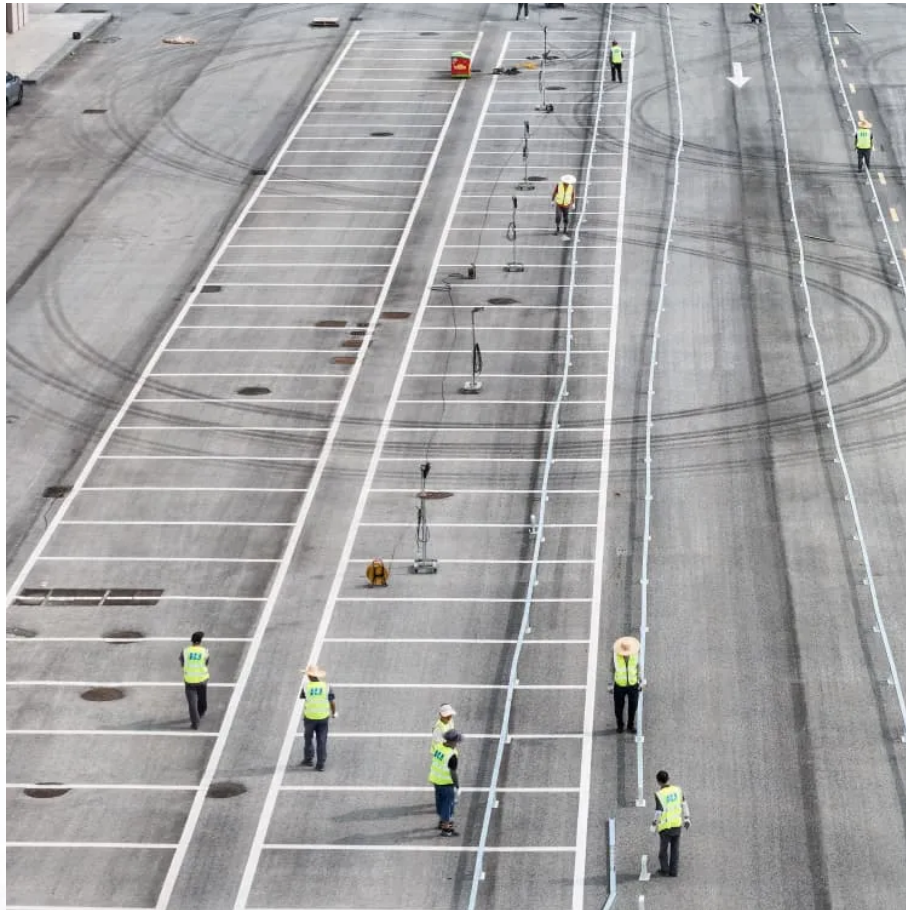

Does a string inverter have a warranty?

Most string inverters come with a 5- to 12-year warranty, though some manufacturers offer extended warranty options for added protection. Since a string inverter failure affects multiple solar panels at once, it can cause

significant system downtime. Some warranties cover replacement costs, but labor and shipping fees may not always be included.
