New Zealand Energy Storage Container BESS



Overview

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Saft, a subsidiary of French energy giant TotalEnergies, will provide Genesis Energy in New Zealand with a 100MW/200MWh utility-scale battery energy storage system (BESS). Confirmed yesterday (19 September), the 2-hour duration BESS will be installed at Huntly Power Station on the country's North.
