In September 2025, the average electricity price in the Latvian bidding area increased to EUR 84,19 per megawatt hour (EUR/MWh), which is 5% more than in August, while compared to September 2024, the price is 0,1% higher. In September, the amount of electricity produced and delivered to the grid in.

The residential electricity price in Latvia is EUR 0.250 per kWh or USD 0.285. The electricity price for businesses is EUR 0.147 kWh or USD 0.168. These retail prices were collected in September 2024 and include the cost of power, distribution and transmission, and all taxes and fees.

Any resident can view current and historical prices, no registration is required to view basic price information. What to do if there is no electricity?

In emergency situations (when there is concern about the danger of damage,

for example broken wires, smoke, burning) or there is no Internet.

In 2024, electricity prices in the Baltic region fluctuate depending on market factors, including supply, demand, geopolitics and generation conditions. For example, at the beginning of November 2024, the Latvian wholesale electricity price on the Nord Pool exchange reached 118.34 EUR/MWh. By.
