# Portable Outdoor Power Supply in Rwanda



## Overview

---

Are there electrical outlets in Rwanda?

No, the electrical outlets in Rwanda are different from those in the United States. In Rwanda electrical outlets of types C & J are used, while the United States has electrical outlets of types A & B. Do I need a travel adapter for Rwanda?

The electrical outlets and power plugs in Rwanda are of types C & J ( see images) .

What type of plugs are used in Rwanda?

Type J - Mainly used in Switzerland and Liechtenstein. Type C plugs will also fit into an outlet of type J. All power sockets in Rwanda provide a standard voltage of 230V with a standard frequency of 50Hz. You can use all your equipment in Rwanda if the outlet voltage in your own country is between 220V-240V.

Do I need a travel adapter for a Rwanda Charger?

However, it is possible you'll need an adapter to plug the charger into a Rwanda outlet. Rwanda uses electrical outlets and power plugs of types C & J ( see images) . If your country uses the same electrical outlets and power plugs, you don't need a travel adapter. Are the electrical outlets and power plugs in your country different?

Which plugs fit in a Type C outlet in Rwanda?

Plugs of type E and F will also fit in a type C outlet. Type J - Mainly used in Switzerland and Liechtenstein. Type C plugs will also fit into an outlet of type J. All power sockets in Rwanda provide a standard voltage of 230V with a standard frequency of 50Hz.

What voltage does a power socket work in Rwanda?

All power sockets in Rwanda provide a standard voltage of 230V with a standard frequency of 50Hz. You can use all your equipment in Rwanda if the outlet voltage in your own country is between 220V-240V. This is the case in most of Europe, Australia, the United Kingdom and most countries in Africa and Asia.

Can I connect my laptop charger to an electrical outlet in Rwanda?

Yes, you can connect your laptop charger to an electrical outlet in Rwanda as long as the outlet is compatible with the charger's voltage and plug type. In Rwanda, the standard voltage is 230V and the standard frequency is 50Hz.
