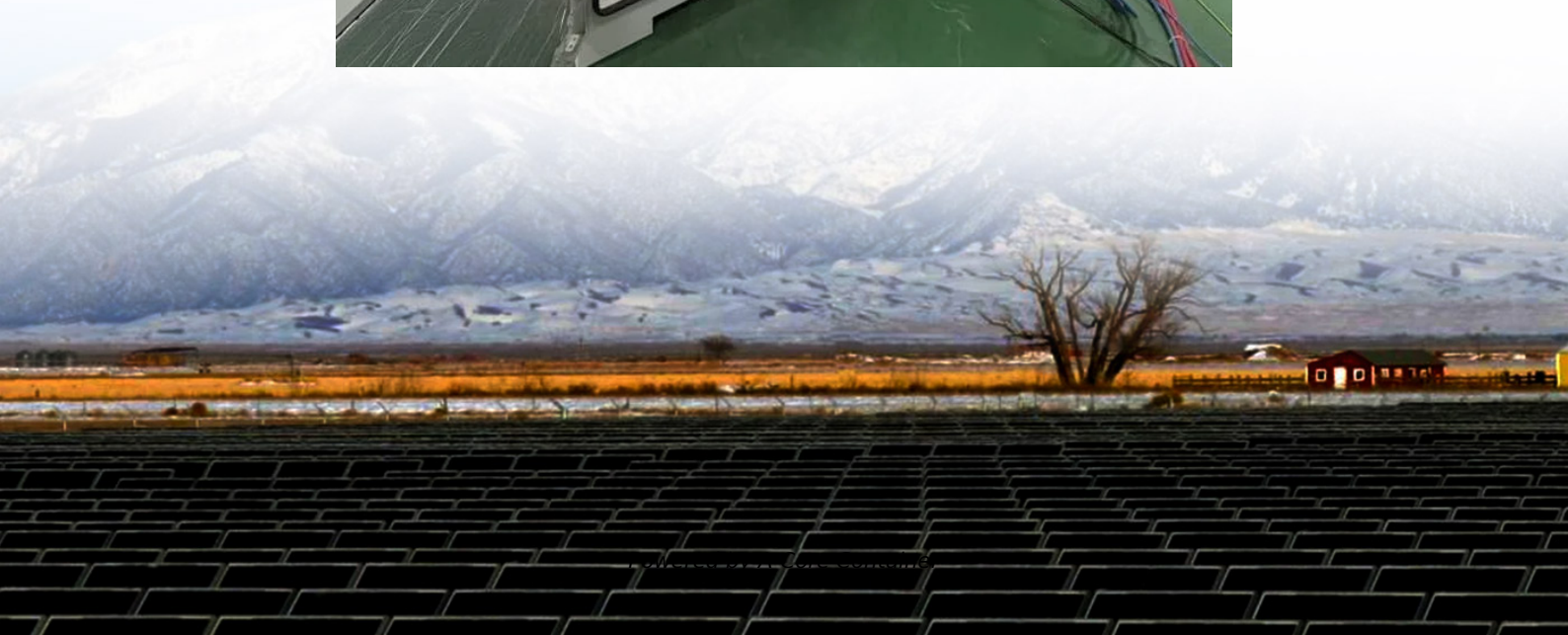

Overview

How much electricity will Rwanda supply by 2024?

By 2024, Rwanda plans to supply electricity to 100 percent of the population (52 percent through grid expansion and 48 percent through off-grid technologies). Though it will not reach this target, new ambitious targets are likely to be set in late 2023 or 2024.

How much electricity does Rwanda use?

Rwanda's electricity consumption has continuously grown, reaching approximately 211.1 million kilowatt by 2023 up from 178.9 million in 2023 kilowatt for domestic and residential facilities. TABLE: Electricity Exportation and importation (Kwh) In the first quarter of 2024, a total of 342.073 GWh of electricity was generated in Rwanda.

How many kilowatts did Rwanda export in 2022?

The total exportation of electricity decreased from 9.6 million kilowatts in 2022 down to 9.1 million kilowatts in 2023 . Rwanda's electricity consumption has continuously grown, reaching approximately 211.1 million kilowatt by 2023 up from 178.9 million in 2023 kilowatt for domestic and residential facilities.

From where does Rwanda buy power?

Rwanda currently purchases power from the Rusizi I plant (with an import capacity of 3.5 MW) and Rusizi II (with an import capacity of 12 MW), both owned by Sinelac. Rwanda buys power from the Rusizi I and Rusizi II plants in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC).

Why does Rwanda need a reliable energy supply?

The Government of Rwanda recognizes that a reliable energy supply is important for social prosperity, human development, and economic growth. The availability of efficient and reliable energy is a prerequisite for these

aspects.
