Should a shipping container be placed on the Right Foundation?

Placing a shipping container on the right foundation will keep it level on a long-term basis. If your shipping container's weight is not evenly distributed across its corner castings, your container may shift and warp over time, leading to serious structural problems.

How do you move a shipping container off the ground?

Cement blocks and railroad ties will raise your shipping container off the ground, which will prevent water from pooling around the bottom and causing corrosion. The foundation styles can also make moving your shipping container a little easier when you no longer need it to be in that location.

How do you build a shipping container pier?

One popular option is the pier foundation, which involves installing a series of concrete or steel piers that are driven or drilled into the ground. The shipping containers are then placed on top of the piers, allowing for better drainage and ventilation beneath the structure.

Can a shipping container be placed on the ground?

Conversions Shipping containers have many different uses. In recent times, they have become almost permanent solutions for traditionally constructed buildings such as homes, business premises, and other living spaces, as well as storage. However, it's not enough to simply place your shipping container on the ground you intend to use.

How do you put a shipping container on top of concrete?

- **Cement blocks:** This approach is also known as "blocking", and involves propping your shipping container on top of concrete blocks. The weight of the shipping container should keep the concrete foundation blocks firmly in place. Blocking is a quick and effective foundation for short-term container

placements.

What is a shipping container pier?

As with piles, piers can also extend above ground level and be used to elevate your building. In this way, they serve as defacto columns as well, helping get your container off the ground without having to use separate metal supports. Piers are the most popular shipping container foundation and the type we recommend for most people.
