Poland's record solar output this spring led to a spike in negative prices and curtailed PV volumes. Negative electricity prices reached a record high in April, with 75 hours seeing prices at or below zero.

While private households in Poland pay 0.22 euros per kilowatt hour, the electricity price for commercial enterprises is 0.39 euros per kilowatt hour. These price differences make photovoltaic systems particularly attractive for companies.

According to the Solar Energy Industries Association, the average price per watt for residential solar projects was \$3.27 in the first half of 2023. That is up slightly from a low of \$2.92 before the pandemic, but down over 50% from the price of \$6.65 per watt in 2010. Will solar power be a good investment in Poland in 2025?

Thanks to additional government subsidies for small private PV systems and high electricity prices of over 30 eurocents per kilowatt hour for companies, investments in own electricity generation in both areas will become attractive in 2025. In September 2024 alone, PV systems with a total power of 363.53 megawatts were installed in Poland.

Are solar panels a good idea in Poland?

Solar energy also has high public support in national polls. A survey commissioned by the Polish Photovoltaic Association in 2022 revealed that more than half of the Poles want solar installations in their neighborhoods, while 2 out of 5 respondents think installing solar panels on all buildings is a good idea.
