Overview

Agratas, Tata Group's global battery business, will build Britain's biggest battery manufacturing facility at the Gravity Smart Campus near Bridgwater, Somerset. Where will Britain's biggest electric vehicle battery factory be built?

More info: Britain's biggest electric vehicle battery factory is to be built in Somerset, it has been announced. The vast gigafactory, near Bridgwater, is set to cost £4bn and will create 4,000 jobs. Battery business Agratas, part of Mumbai-based Tata Group, is behind the plans.

Where are EV batteries made in the UK?

The Sunderland plant, operational since 2012, is Europe's first and the UK's only EV battery factory for over a decade, with an annual capacity of 1.8 GWh. In July 2021, AESC announced the construction of AESC's second Sunderland battery plant, which will be the UK's largest gigafactory.

What is National Grid's battery factory?

The battery factory is the latest major grid connection National Grid is undertaking across its transmission and distribution networks. Recent transmission connections include the UK's largest transmission-connected battery at Drax in Yorkshire, part of the 3GW of generation and several hundred megawatts of demand capacity added in the last year.

National Grid has officially begun a multi-million pound electrical engineering project that will help bring power to the UK's biggest EV battery factory.
