Great British Energy's first project will put rooftop solar panels on 200 schools and 200 hospitals - cutting energy bills. Hundreds of schools, NHS trusts and communities across the UK will benefit from new rooftop solar power and renewable schemes to save money on their energy bills, thanks to a.

The new solar panel initiative is backed by a £200 million investment from Great British Energy and will see rooftop solar panels installed on around 200 schools and 200 NHS sites. The new plan is expected to create huge savings, with hundreds of millions of pounds redirected back into public.

This project is an integral part of a wider sustainability strategy, expanding the successful solar rollout to around 70 new healthcare.
