Emirati Renewable energy company Masdar (Abu Dhabi Future Energy Company) and Emirates Water and Electricity Company (EWEC) are developing the trailblazing solar and battery storage project.

Will Dubai's new solar power plant be able to operate 24/7?

The facility will be capable of operating 24/7 on renewable energy. This will also be the world’s first 24/7 solar PV, battery storage gigascale project, according to Abu Dhabi Future Energy Company (Masdar) and Emirates Water and Electricity Company (EWEC), which are part of the project.

What is the largest combined solar and battery energy storage system?

Once it’s online, will become the largest combined solar and battery energy storage system (BESS) in the world. Located in Abu Dhabi, the project will feature a 5.2 GW solar PV plant coupled with a 19 gigawatt-hour (GWh) BESS.
